

IOM can help you make an informed choice about returning voluntarily to your home country or to a country where you have the right of entry and long-term residency.



Am I eligible for AVR/R?

IOM caseworkers are ready to speak to you about your eligibility for AVR/R

What will it cost?

All IOM assistance is free of cost.

How soon can I travel?

IOM will keep you informed about how long it will take to organise everything that is needed for you to return. This may depend on travel document processing and flight availability.
