

### Skilled Migration Update – Victoria



The Victoria Skilled Migration program is now open with some very exciting changes.

- ✓ Open for onshore (living in Victoria) and offshore applicants in the subclass 190 and 491 pathways.
- ✓ Open for all occupations on the Department of Home Affairs' list.
- ✓ Applicants are no longer required to have STEM skills and be working in a target sector to apply.
- ✓ Health occupations are prioritized for the subclass 491 pathway.

The following nomination levels have been allocated to Victoria for the 2022-2023 program year.

Skilled Nominated (subclass 190) visa 9000	Skilled work Regional (subclass 491) visa 2400	Business Innovation and Investment Program 170

To apply for Victorian state nomination, applicants must submit a Registration of interest (ROI) and be invited by the Victoria Government. Applicants must also meet the visa requirements of the Department of Home Affairs.

### Skilled Migration Update – South Australia

South Australia Skilled Migration Program is also now open for onshore and offshore skilled migrants through six different nomination streams for the subclass 190 and 491 pathways.

Stream	Who can apply
<b>South Australian Graduate<sup>1</sup></b>	International students graduating in South Australia from a CRICOS registered education provider <sup>2</sup> .
<b>Working in South Australia<sup>2</sup></b>	Skilled migrants living in and working in the nominated occupation in South Australia.  Temporary visa holders, international graduates, self-employed applicants and sub-contractors may be eligible.
<b>Outer Regional South Australia stream<sup>3</sup></b>	Skilled migrants contributing to supporting regional South Australia communities and businesses.  Working Holiday Makers visa applicants may also apply under this pathway.
<b>Long-Term Residents stream<sup>4</sup></b>	South Australian residents (including SHEV visa holders) who do not qualify under other nomination streams and not currently working in their nominated occupation may be eligible.
<b>Highly Skilled and Talented stream<sup>5</sup></b>	Highly skilled migrants living in South Australia, other Australian states, and territories. They need to demonstrate their talent and/or support innovation in South Australia.
<b>Offshore Stream<sup>6</sup></b>	Offshore Applicants
